TREASURER UPDATE

We have only two months of actual operating expenses for 2025, so it is early to make predictions. The good news is we are close to break even in spite of the fact that almost \$10,000 of mulch and pressure washing services were performed in January 2025 that were budgeted in 2024. Final numbers for 2024 show a favorable operating budget amount of about \$19,000 (due in some part to the delay in mulch and pressure washing.) The reserves stand at \$514,000. Villa painting is, by far, the largest expenditure that is taken from reserves and we estimate we will be using a total of \$337,000 in 2025 and 2026 to paint the villas. After 2026, we can begin replenishing funds for future villa painting. We have scheduled out this painting for a number of years to ensure we have adequate funds in the future to cover this expenditure. This spreadsheet, in addition to the Reserve Study done last year, will be very helpful as we prepare future budgets so there are no unexpected surprises.
